## **The Club at White Oaks Hosting the Canadian Squash Championships**

Wednesday, May 2nd marks the opening of the 100th Anniversary 2012 Morris Group Canadian Squash Championships being held this year at The Club at White Oaks, Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario. Over 290 entrants are registered in both Men's and Women's Open divisions along with age group categories of 30+ right through to 65+.

Men's and Women's National Teams will be fighting it out for the title of National Champion including Shahir Razik, seeded number one in the Men's open and Sam Cornett, seeded number one in the Women's Open, both of Toronto. Number 2 seeds for men is Shawn Delierre from Montreal and Miranda Ranieri from Waterloo. Matches begin Wednesday, May 2nd with the Men's and Women's Open and A division with final matches being held on Saturday, May 5th. All other division finals will be held on Sunday, May 6th.

There will be some truly inspiring matches being played at White Oaks over these dates.
